

USING CD 10 REMOTE CONTROL

CD 10 remote control replaces both CD 8 and CD 9 remote controls. CD 10 is a combination of both CD 8 and CD 9.

APPLIES TO C 538, C 545BEE, C 546BEE, C 565BEE AND C 568

- 1 **ON:** Unit is powered up from Standby mode to operating mode.
- 2 OFF: Unit goes to Standby mode.
- **3 RANDOM:** Tracks/files are played at random mode.

PROGRAM: Enter or exit program mode

REPEAT: Track, file, folder or whole disc is repeated.

RPT A-B: Playback sequence is repeated.

- 4 STOP: Playback is stopped.
- 5 ▲: Disc tray is opened or closed.
- 6 ►► : Next track/ file is played.
 - Idd: Beginning of current track/file or previous track/file is played.
 - ▶▶ : Playback is scanned or searched fast forward.
 - **◄** : Playback is scanned or searched fast backward.
 - ▶: Playback is started.
- 7 II: Playback is paused.
- 8 FILE: Scroll up or down WMA or MP3 file list.
- 9 FOLDER: Scroll up or down the folder list.
- **10 DIM:** Display brightness is reduced, restored or turned off.

ENTER: MP3 or WMA file is selected for playback.

- 11 NUMBER BUTTONS 0 9: Track or file number is directly accessed or selected.
- **12 DELETE:** Programmed track/file is cleared.
- **13 TIME:** Playback time and other information are shown. This has the same function as the front panel DISPLAY button.
- 14 SHIFT: Use in combination with CD, USB, OPT, SRC and FILTER function buttons

APPLIES TO C 546BEE, C 565BEE AND C 568

- **15 CD:** Press and hold SHIFT for around 1 second and then CD to select CD as the active source.
 - **USB:** Press and hold SHIFT for around 1 second and then USB to select USB as the active source.
 - **OPT:** Press and hold SHIFT for around 1 second and then OPT to select Optical as the active source. Applies only to C 565BEE.
 - **SRC:** Press and hold SHIFT for around 1 second and then SRC to select desired SRC level. Repeat the same process to toggle and select desired SRC level. Applies only to C 565BEE.

APPLIES TO C 545BEE, C 546BEE, C 565BEE AND C 568

16 FILTER: Press and hold SHIFT for around 1 second and then FILTER to select desired FILTER level. Repeat the same process to toggle and select desired FILTER level - filter number (applies to C 565BEE and C 568) or switch between NORMAL and SLOW bandwidth (applies to C 545BEE and C 546BEE).
